There are a large number of AAC Apps available today and many of them offer quality options for augmentative communication. The key is to know what the communicator's NEEDS are and then match those to the FEATURES required from an APP.

Apps Summary

Robust Apps:

- Wide range of vocabulary included
- Large number of picture icons included (usually thousands)
- Various page layout options; can usually start out very simple
- Usually can do both pictures and spelling
- Higher quality voices with choices of types and/or languages
- Premade vocabulary options (significant # of premade pages included)
- Can formulate sentences using some core vocabulary (optional)
- Can independently navigate to vocabulary
- Usually more expensive because of more options offered
- May be more complex to program

More Features Apps:

- Varied amount of pictures provided (note what “type” you want; digital photos, picture icons, etc.)
- Usually provides some pictures
- Usually does not do spelling
- Voice type varies: digitized (recorded speech) and/or synthesized (or referred to as text-to-speech sometimes).
- Vocabulary offered includes premade pages (may be additional cost)
- Some have ability to formulate simpler phrases / sentences.
- Instructional resources, website information, and email support varies.
- Usually mid-priced range since they have more features.
- Ease of programming based on the number of features offered.

Starter Apps

- Varied amount of pictures provided (or none at all). For most, use your own photos
- Voice type is often digitized (recorded speech).
- Vocabulary offered is basic “starters” or easy to “start from scratch” for simpler communication needs
- Some have ability to formulate simpler phrases / sentences.
- Instructional resources, website information, and email support varies.
- Usually less expensive since they have less features.
- Most easier to program due to less features offered.

Simple Apps

- Very simple. Does not need side-by-side comparison. Continue research with iTunes link.
- Single key or 2 key options
- Addition of pictures may be limited or not possible
- Few if any pictures are provided
- Usually digitized speech (recorded)
- Lower cost
- Easy to program

Spelling/Text-to-Speech Apps

- Most are primarily for literate individuals who can spell
- A few may also have pictures (indicated with **)
- A wide variety and quality of voices available
- Features vary widely; in general, the more expensive, the more features available (such as word prediction, pre-programmed vocabulary, categorization, keyboard layout, etc.)
